Sotelo was traveling in a convoy when a rocket propelled grenade struck his vehicle.

Traveling in a government vehicle when an explosive device detonated and struck the vehicle.

Died of wounds when his convoy was hit by an improvised explosive device in Baghdad

Killed in an explosion during a mine clearing operation near the city of Karbala
